FORM 3 - SOCIETY ACT

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is the "VANCOUVER ISLAND UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION".
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) to solicit, receive, record, own, maintain and transfer or dispose of real and personal property, donations, bequests, equipment or any other gifts in keeping with the purposes of the Foundation and to apply all or part of such gifts at the discretion of the Directors to support directly or indirectly the goals and objectives of Vancouver Island University;
 - b) to support and coordinate fund raising activities carried on by or on behalf of Vancouver Island University;
 - c) to act as recipient of and, where so appointed, as trustee for funds or property given for designated purposes or general uses in keeping with the Foundation's objectives;
 - d) to provide services to Vancouver Island University relating to the management and investment of trust funds;
 - e) to develop, foster and encourage public knowledge and awareness of the purposes and objectives of Vancouver Island University;
 - f) to enter into contracts or arrangements with any person, authority or corporation whether public or private which in the discretion of the Directors are conducive to the attainment of the Foundation's purposes;
 - g) to provide by way of grants, loans, or other means, financial assistance to Vancouver Island University and its students.
